Two other meatless meals, which together are less than the full meal, are also permitted. <b>Abstinence</b> = Meat (and soup or gravy made from meat) <b>may not</b> be taken at all. <b>Partial Abstinence</b> = Meat (and soup or gravy made from meat) <b>may be eaten only once.</b>
